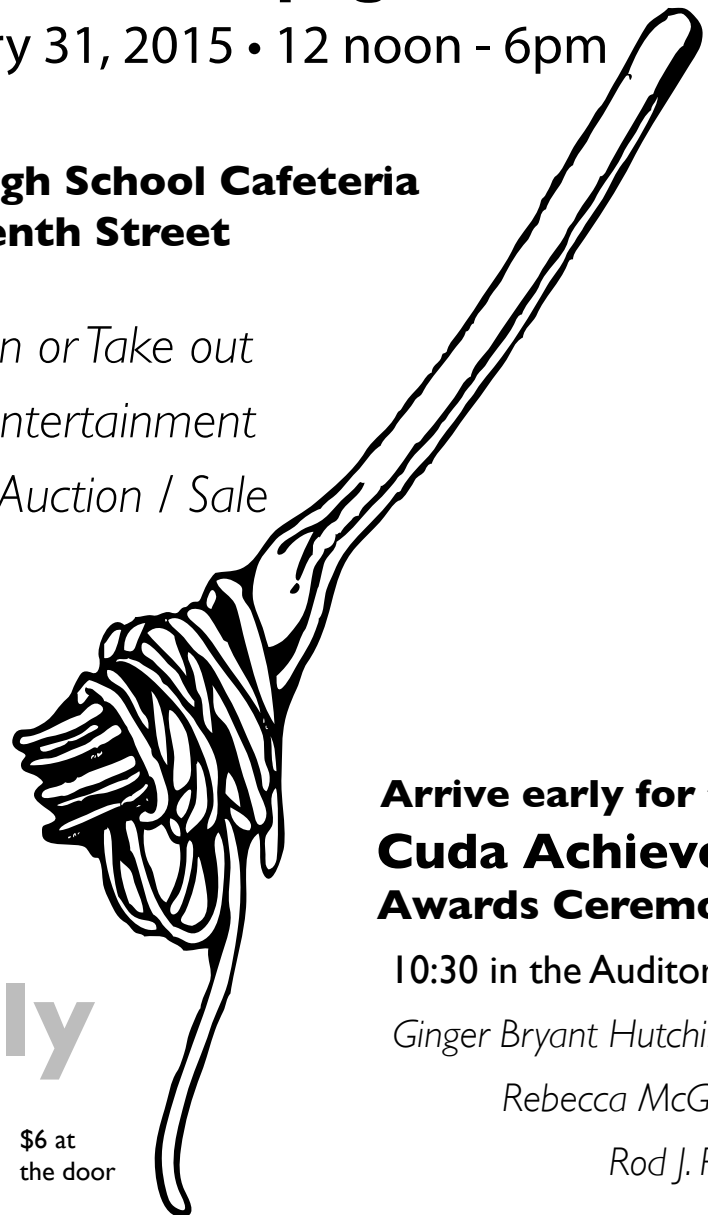

**Rod J. Perry** is a 1991 graduate of New Smyrna Beach High School, and a 1996 graduate of Mississippi State University with a degree in Marketing and Professional Golf Management. He turned professional in golf with the PGA in 1998 and has gone on to distinguish himself in his chosen sport in many ways. Among his many accomplishments Rod has been chosen PGA of America Player of the Year in 2012 and 2013, winner of the PGA of America Stroke Play Championship in 2007, one of 10 PGA of America Golfers selected for International Competition in England, and winner of the 2014 PGA Senior-Junior Championship. Already chosen as a member of the Mississippi State University Professional Golf Management Program Hall of Fame, Rod is currently the PGA Head Golf Professional at Crane Lakes Golf and Country Club in Port Orange, Florida.



**Rebecca McGinnis** is a 1983 graduate of New Smyrna Beach High School. Legally blind from birth, she holds a Master's degree in History of Art from NYU and Museum Studies from University of Leicester. She is currently a doctoral candidate in Cognitive Psychology pursuing research relating to visual impairment and mental imagery at Teachers College, Columbia University. Rebecca is co-convenor with Art Beyond Sight of the bi-annual Multimodal Approaches to Learning conference, 2005-2012 and she is an adjunct lecturer in the Museum Studies MA Program at Johns Hopkins University, teaching Accessibility in the Museum, a course she developed. Her international experience includes directing access audits and training for over fifty museums in the United Kingdom and in the United States, and major collaborations with the British Museum and National Portrait Gallery in London. Her current position is the Museum Educator overseeing Access and Community Programs at The Metropolitan Museum of Art, New York City.



**Ginger Bryant Hutchinson** also graduated from New Smyrna Beach High School in 1983. After studying at Jacksonville State University in Jacksonville, Alabama, DBCC, and University of Central Florida with her eye on Fashion Merchandizing and business, and all the while working part time for her father in his veterinarian clinic, Ginger finally decided that her true love was working with animals. Changing her major from business to biology, she attended Ross University and graduated with her DVM degree in 2002. She began working that summer at Glencoe Veterinary Hospital and after two years had the opportunity, along with her sister, to purchase the practice. In 2012, she and two other family members formed a non profit organization called Volusia Society for Aid to Animals whose primary task is to take care of all the displaced, abandoned animals for the city of Edgewater.

Hazel Haughton Massey Wilkinson ('34) died September 15, 2014. The last living member of the class of 1934, Mrs. Wilkinson was the Librarian for the city of Edgewater in the early 1960s, and later worked as the registrar at New Smyrna Beach High School, until her retirement, where she was known as Ms. Massey or simply "Aunt Hazel" to hundreds of students.

Word has been received that William Myers ('44) died February 18, 2014.

Audrey Wall Hancock ('45) died October 9, 2014. A member of the New Smyrna Beach Old Timers Ladies Lunch Group, Audrey had lived in Orlando for a number of years where she was an employee for the Orange County School Board and was a title examiner in the oil and gas business with her husband. She returned to New Smyrna in 1985 and is survived by her son B.C. "Chuck" Ankney, Jr., four grandchildren and nine great grandchildren.

Doris Burch Massey ('48) died September 10, 2014. Doris was the 13th child of George and Doris Massey and was a lifelong resident of Edgewater. Mrs. Massey was a 50 year licensed real estate broker and was a member of many business and community organizations in Volusia County. She is survived by two sons, Dale and Dorian, and four grandchildren.

Barbara Elderton Oxar ('48) died September 25, 2013 in North Miami, Florida. She worked as a dental assistant for her husband Dr. Charles E. Oxar, then worked for 37 years as a church secretary. She is survived by son George and daughter Virginia, six grandchildren and four great grandchildren.

Dolores Doty Kennard ('49) died October 16, 2014. A graduate of Stetson University with a degree in elementary education and art, she

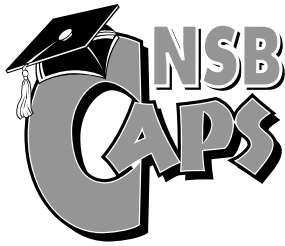
